HANNIBAL DOCKETS
INCLEMENT WEATHER

Unless other information is supplied in the telephone message, the Court will not travel to the Hannibal Courthouse during inclement weather. Every effort will be made to conduct scheduled hearings at their scheduled times, by means of a telephone conference call between the St. Louis Courthouse and the Courtroom in Hannibal. If weather conditions prevent Counsel in the Hannibal area from traveling to the Hannibal Courthouse, or Court personnel are unable to travel to the St. Louis Courthouse, hearings will be continued to the next regularly scheduled Hannibal docket, unless all parties agree to an earlier setting, and verify the setting with the Court.
