This communication contains information about news, events, and activities at the Bankruptcy Court. While much of this information is contained on the Court's website, I convey it to you for immediate use.

- With the changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure becoming effective December 1, 2010, the Court has made conforming changes to its Local Rules. The Public Notice found at <http://www.moeb.uscourts.gov/pdfs/Revised%20LR%207056.pdf> addresses L.R. 7056 Summary Judgment and the Order found at http://www.moeb.uscourts.gov/pdfs/local_rules/2010/Revised%20Order%20adopting%20interim%20Rule%201007-I%2012-2010%20-%20with%20Links.pdf addresses the increase in time allotted to debtors to submit the personal financial management certificate.
- Effective December, 2010, the Court will make audio recordings of select matters held before Judge Charles E. Rendlen, III, available to the public via the Court's Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system.
