Notice of Error Changes

As of November 1, 2010, the Notice of Error process at the court will change.

- The court will no longer send out informational notice of errors. If a change is made to a docket entry an e-mail notice will automatically be sent out to all active attorneys and the trustee in that case. Changes made to docket entries almost always consist of an annotation being added to the docket text. The e-mail notice will list what the docket text was and what it was changed to. Since annotations to docket entries will automatically be sent out, the court will no longer be docketing corrective entries also.
- The language used to make annotations to docket entries has been updated to read more clearly for all users.
- The court will continue to send out Notice of Errors that require action to be taken by the filer of the document. The language in the Notice of Error docket entry has been changed to read more clearly to all users.
- The Notice of Error forms have been updated to reflect that no more informational notices will be sent out.
