

## **NOTICE:**

### **THE COURTHOUSE IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, WITH THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY RESTRICTIONS:**

- Persons must not have COVID or COVID symptoms (fever, cough, etc.) nor any contact with such persons for the previous two weeks;
- Persons must have a temperature reading of below 100.0 degrees;
- Persons must wear masks and observe social distancing in all courthouse common areas;
- Judges or agency heads may enforce additional limits within their respective spaces.

### **ALTHOUGH THE COURTHOUSE IS NOW OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, EVERY COURT OR AGENCY IN THE COURTHOUSE REMAINS AVAILABLE FOR REMOTE SERVICES TO THOSE WHO ARE UNABLE TO CONDUCT IN-PERSON BUSINESS:**

- For those whose conditions do not allow them to conduct business in the courthouse in person, each agency is required to provide you with contact information so that your concerns can still be addressed to that particular agency; to wit:
- If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney;
- If you are an attorney scheduled to appear in District Court before a district or magistrate judge, or have other business with the District Court, please contact that chambers directly or contact the Clerk's Office at 314-244-7900, or refer to the Court's website [www.moed.uscourts.gov](http://www.moed.uscourts.gov) for clerk's office and chambers contact information. Persons needing to file documents in person but needing to preserve social distancing may drop District Court filings in the District Court drop box on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Courthouse.
