To Attorneys, CM/ECF Users, and the Public:

This communication contains information about news, events, and activities at the Bankruptcy Court. While much of this information is contained on the Court's website, I convey it to you for immediate use.

- **Public Comment Period for Local Rules Revisions**

Please be advised that the Court will be making revisions to its Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure this year to take effect December 1, 2018. As part of this effort, the Court is placing the proposed Local Rules revisions out for a 30-day comment period. - **Reaffirmation Agreements**

The Court has streamlined e-filing practice for reaffirmation agreements from 3 events to 1 event. This new event will ask a series of questions about the reaffirmation agreement to be filed. Attorney filers can find the event at this pathway on the CM/ECF events menu: Bankruptcy Events - - > Other Miscellaneous Events - - > Reaffirmation Agreement. Limited User filers can find the event at this pathway on the CM/ECF events menu: Bankruptcy Events - - > Creditor Filings - - > Reaffirmation Agreement.

- **GovDelivery**

Starting today, the Court will begin using a service called GovDelivery to communicate electronically with bankruptcy attorneys, CM/ECF users, and the public regarding news, events, and activities at the U.S. Bankruptcy Court. GovDelivery is a subscription based email delivery service used by many Federal Courts nationwide. As a subscriber, you will automatically receive updates from the Court. For certain communications, you have been automatically subscribed based the existence of account information for you in the Court's CM/ECF system. From time to time, the Court may offer additional subscription topics in which you may be interested.
