THE COURTHOUSE IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

- Persons attending in-person courthouse proceedings
- Persons authorized by a judge or agency head or their designee to enter for a specific purpose
- Judges or agency heads may enforce civil authorities' current limits on sizes of gatherings

EVEN IF YOU ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING DUE TO ONE OF THE ABOVE EXCEPTIONS, YOU WILL BE DENIED ENTRY TO THE FACILITY IF YOU:

- Have travelled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
- Reside or have had close contact with someone who has travelled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
