**ORDER VACATING GENERAL ORDER NO. 20-1 AND GENERAL ORDER NO. 20-5
EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2022**

On February 19, 2020, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Missouri (the "Court") entered General Order No. 20-1 (Interim Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure Required by Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019) adopting Interim Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007, 1020, 2009, 2012, 2015, 3010, 3011, 3014, 3016, 3017.1, (new) 3017.2, 3018, and 3019.

On April 20, 2020, the Court entered General Order 20-5 (General Order Adopting Amendments to Interim Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1020 to Implement the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) adopting Interim Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the two General Orders are hereby vacated effective December 1, 2022, as the interim rules at issue relating to the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019 and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act of 2020 are part of the Bankruptcy Rules changes effective December 1, 2022.


